Membership Categories

Accredited - Is a person who has been a professional Cinematographer for a minimum of 8 years including at least the last 3 years as an ACS Full member. They have applied for Accreditation and an ACS Accreditation Panel has deemed their work to be of a high enough standard to use the letters ACS after their name. These letters are reserved exclusively for those whom the Panel has bestowed this honour.

Full - A Full member is a person who is and has been active as a professional cinematographer in the motion picture or television industry for a period of five (5) years or more, and is over the age of twenty-one (21) years.

Active - An Active member is a person who is a cinematographer but does not meet the qualifications of a full member and without limiting the generality of the foregoing shall include: a camera operator & an assistant cinematographer.

Associate - Is a person who is involved in cinematography, but is NOT a member of the Camera Department. An Associate Member may be a Sponsor or dignitary who is invited by the ACS to join the Society or may be a person who is not in the Camera Department but is working in the allied Departments of Lighting, Gripping, Art, SFX, VFX, Visual Post-Production, Camera Equipment Supply and Preparation, Camera and Lens Technician.

Student - Is a person aged 16 years or older who is either: Undertaking a course, recognised by the National Executive in film, television and screen production techniques in a college, university or academy or Gaining work experience with an industry company or production or A Secondary student aged 16 years and older who is actively engaged and has a keen interest in cinematography.

CineKids - Is a young person aged between 10 - 15 years, who has a passion for cameras and filmmaking. When CineKids members turn 16 years old they may be upgraded to a Student member. See <http://www.cinematographer.org.au/cms/page.asp?ID=20012> for CineKids application form.

Retired - Is a member, aged over 50, with ten years standing or more who has been a Cinematographer or Camera Crew member and due to age or illness has retired from active participation in cinematography and is no longer employed in any capacity. Approved Retired Members are not liable for membership fees.

Honorary - is a person upon whom honorary membership has been bestowed. An Honorary Member is not liable for joining or membership fees.

Life - Is an Accredited, Cinematographer, Camera Crew or Retired member who, due to long and distinguished services to the Society, has been granted life membership. A Life Member is not liable for membership fees.

Membership Fees *The ACS membership year is concurrent with the financial year; e.g. July 1 ~ June 30.
Quarterly pro rata fees may apply if you join later in the financial year but the full joining fee will still apply.*
